- We will again be working on the Wilderness issue in the coming months. Wilderness designation blocks sportsmen access, trout stocking, steam restoration, and wildlife habitat improvement on our National Forests. There are national efforts by environmental groups to make your public lands national parks. This means NO HUNTING!
- The Division of Natural Resources made an informative presentation on the status of the captive cervid monitoring program. Look for this issue to arise again this winter in the legislature as the captive cervid people again try to move regulatory authority to the Department of Agriculture. This essentially means no regulations since there are no enforcement people in this agency. We cannot continue to compromise the health of the deer herd and our deer hunting heritage through the unregulated movement of these animals.
