- The West Virginia Wildlife Federation (WVWF) is attending meetings and voicing our opposition to additional wilderness areas on the Monongahela NF that prevent sportsmen's access.
- WVWF is supporting legislation providing hunter education in the schools and opposing legislative proposals to transfer authority of captive deer permits from DNR to Department of Agriculture and set deer hunting and bass size limits by the legislature instead of the Natural Resources Commission.
- WVWF is looking for Regional Directors and Regional Representatives to represent sportsmen and sportsmen's clubs at the WVWF Board of Directors meetings.
- The Board of Directors recognized the need to poll members on issues facing the sportsmen of WV on a daily basis and decided to use email approval for actions to be taken in a timely manner.
- The Executive Secretary position will remain unfilled for the immediate future.
- The role of the Camo Coalition was discussed and it was decided that the Camo Coalition should be a sportsmen's action alert network operating under the WVWF.
